From the Range Orientation Officer: Guests on the Range! Members may bring guests to the range. But, remember, guests are not familiar with range procedures and need supervision! Unsupervised guests are a potential safety hazard. At a minimum, if you bring a guest to the range, make sure to give them a briefing on range procedures, especially how we go "Hot" and "Cold." You must determine to what degree you need to supervise a guest. Experienced shooters need very little. First time shooters must have close and constant supervision. Final thought! Only bring the number of guests that you can personally supervise and control.
