**M1 Only Match:** The annual 100 yd M1 Garand match will be fired on Dec. 1st. Any M1 Garand with issue sights may be used. Following the M1 match there will be an M1 Carbine match. The course of fire for both events will be the National Match Course. These are not NRA matches and the scores will not be sent in for classification purposes. Other rifles may be fired for practice. "Accurized" M1's are allowed in this match.
