The Pistol Match will be fired concurrently with the High Power match. Any pistol may be used. Loaner pistols and ammo will be available. There is no charge for the pistol match and no awards. The Worley Trophy will be given to the club member with the highest total High Power and Pistol score.

John C. Garand Match: The fall Garand match will be fired on the 9th of November this year. Garands will fire on the 200 yard line, 50 rounds, Carbines will fire on the 100 yard line, 40 rounds..(this may be fired on the 200 also), if time permits, and the Bonus match, 10 rounds will be determined later...be ready. Sign up starts at 0700, first round at 0830, earlier if we have a full relay. All match proceeds will go to the M1's for Vets Program.....see you there.

"Accurized" M1's are allowed in this match.
