Smallbore F-Class

The NRA has sanctioned an F Class Rifle category for Small Bore Prone. Rules for the equipment can be found in section 3.1.1 Small Bore F Class Rifle of the NRA Small Bore Rule Book.

Basically, in the target class, you shoot on the ground using a bi pod or other rest for front support and various devices for butt support. You can shoot irons or scope. The club has purchased the correct F class targets for 50 yards and 100 yards and anyone wishing to shoot F Class can shoot along the Small Bore prone shooters at the regularly scheduled matches, second Saturday of the month. The course of fire will require 120 rounds for record and you will shoot 60 rounds at 50 yards, and 60 rounds at 100 yards. Indoor .22 Gallery Pistol Match

We had ten shooters participate in the first indoor pistol match at Larry's. The next match will have two relays to accommodate all who have expressed interest.

Date: June 9, 2015

Time: 6:30 PM

Location: Larry's, 2405 N Memorial Pkwy, Huntsville, AL 35810

Match Fee: \$20

Course of Fire: Total of 90 Rds 22 LR at 50 feet with no sighters, including:

NM Bullseye 30 Rds

Plus

Slow Fire.....20 Rds

Timed Fire.....20 Rds

Rapid Fire.....20 Rds

Arrival, Parking and Entering Larry's: We have been asked to drive around the left side of the store and park behind the main store building (there is a dumpster in this area) near the back door. The parking area is lighted. After store is closed the range master will unlock the back door and let B&G shooters into the range thru that door. It is recommend shooters have B&G membership card or badge and can be admitted individually. Shooters should arrive between 6:00-6:15 and congregate in the area mentioned above to enter as group after the public shooters have been cleared from the range.

NOTE: As the purpose of these pistol matches is to have some fun, and competition, we encourage members who have never fired a match, but are interested, to come out. Do not worry about not having a match pistol or other competition equipment. Bring whatever (in safe operating condition) .22 pistol, at least 100 rounds of ammunition, something to write with, ear and eye protection. You must shoot the match if you want to shoot, even if empty points are available, since people just shooting for fun would be a distraction. We are still working out the details, but we want members to have fun.

NRA conventional pistol competition consists of firing slow, timed, and rapid fire. This is done at 50 and 25 yards outdoors and almost exclusively at 50 feet indoors. Generally an outdoor match will consist of 20 shots, slow fire at 50 yards (2 10-shot strings, 10 minutes per string), 20 shots, timed fire at 25 yards (4 5-shot strings, 20 seconds per string), 20 shots, rapid fire at 25 yards (4 5-shot strings, 10 seconds per string), and the National Match Course (10-shots, slow fire at 50 yards, 10-shots timed fire, and 10-shots rapid fire). This match consists of 90-shots for a possible aggregate total of 900 points.
